- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has made it significantly easier for insiders to trade in shares of their companies by amending the Prohibition of Insider Trading (PIT) regulations.
- The amended norms provide flexibility in the 'trading plan' of a company's key managerial personnel and will come into effect after 3 months.

Genius

Definition of Insiders:

- Insiders are individuals within a company who have access to **Unpublished Price-Sensitive Information** (**UPSI**), typically senior management and officials.
- The time required for insiders to inform the board about their buy/sell decision has been reduced from six months to four months.

- Insiders can now set price limits within a range of **20%** (**both upper and lower**) from the closing price on the day they submit the trading plan.
- Insiders have the flexibility to cancel the trading plan.
- They can choose not to execute trades if the execution price falls outside the predetermined limits set in the trading plan.
- If trades are not executed as per the plan, insiders must inform the company's compliance officer within two trading days after the plan ends, providing reasons and supporting documents.

About the Kavach:

- Initial development of **Kavach started in 2012** under the name Train Collision Avoidance System (TCAS) and completed development in 2022.
- It is an **indigenously developed Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system** by the Research Design and Standards Organisation (RDSO) in collaboration with the Indian industry.
- Kavach has been promoted as being the cheapest ATP system available in the world, costing roughly 50 lakh (five million) rupees per kilometre to operate compared to about two crore (20 million) rupees worldwide.

Recently in News :

- Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw assessed the development of the enhanced Automatic Train Protection System (ATP) known as Kavach 4.0 at Rail Bhawan.
- Kavach 3.2 is currently operational on high-density routes.
- Indian Railways initiated ATP technology adoption in 2016 with the Train Collision Avoidance System(TCAS).

- Indian cities Mamallapuram (Tamil Nadu), Jaipur (Rajasthan) and Mysore (Karnataka) were already added in the list of World Craft City.
- As of now, at least 10 different forms of craftsmanship survive in Srinagar and its suburbs, including papier-mache, walnut wood carving, carpets, Sozni embroidery and Pashmina and Kani shawls.
