- Food inflation surged to **10.87 per cent** during the month.

Explanation :

- As per the government's report, the **Non-performing assets** (NPA)have been around 6% under the **Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme** (ECLGS).
- This means the cost to provide a full guarantee under the scheme will be much less than anticipated.
- NPAs reported under ECLGS amount to approximately **RS.22,000 crore**, which is 6% of the guaranteed loans.
- As per RBI, an NPA is a loan where interest and/or instalment of principal remain overdue for more than 90 days in respect of a term loan.
- According to the latest Financial Stability Report by RBI, the **gross nonperforming assets (GNPA) ratio** for scheduled commercial banks fell to a multi-year low of **2.8% at the end of March 2024.**

About Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) :

- ECLGS was **launched** in **May 2020** to provide liquidity support to businesses adversely impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown.
- The scheme covers loans sanctioned under the 'Guaranteed Emergency Credit Line' up to March 31, 2023, or until guarantees for an amount of Rs.5-lakh crore are issued, whichever is earlier.
- It provides 100% guarantee coverage to banks and NBFCs on credit extended to business enterprises/MSMEs based on their loan outstanding as of February 29, 2020.
- Eligibility : Initially targeted at MSMEs, the scheme was later expanded to include borrowers from 26 stressed sectors identified by the Kamath Committee, as well as the healthcare and hospitality sectors.
- Total liquidity support of Rs.3.68 lakh crore was extended to 1.19 crore businesses.
- MSMEs represent 95% of the number of guarantees and about 65% of the amount of guarantees issued.

Explanation:

- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has **developed** new **standards for** lenders to follow before categorising **loan accounts as fraudulent**.
- To ensure compliance with natural justice principles, which require that both parties in a dispute be heard before making a decision.
- The guidelines follow a Supreme Court judgement dated March 27, 2023, which mandates that borrowers must be given a hearing before their accounts are classified as fraud.
- The RBI has updated its master direction on "**Fraud Risk Management**", in which it has been mandated that lenders have to issue a detailed show-cause notice (SCN) to persons, entities, and promoters/whole-time and executive directors against whom there are allegations of fraud.
- Borrowers must be given at least 21 days to respond to the SCN.

- The master direction applies to commercial banks; upper-, middle-, and base-layer non-banking financial companies; all India financial institutions; and cooperative banks.
- The Fraud Risk Management Policy should be reviewed by the board at least once every three years.
- A special committee of the board, known as the Special Committee for Monitoring and Follow-up of Fraud Cases (SCBMF), must be constituted.
- The SCBMF should consist of at least three board members, including a whole-time director and two independent/non-executive directors.
- The SCBMF will oversee the effectiveness of fraud risk management, review fraud cases, conduct root cause analysis, and suggest measures to strengthen internal controls and minimize fraud incidence.

- The **137th edition** of the All England Championship ,famous as **Wimbledon Championship**, was held at Wimbledon in England from 1-14 July 2024.
- It is the **oldest tennis tournament** in the world and was held for the **first time in 1877** and organised by the All England Lawn Tennis & Croquet Club Limited at Wimbledon, London, England.
- Carlos Alcaraz of Spain and Barbosa Krejcikova of Czech Republic won the men's and women's single title respectively at the 2024 Wimbledon Tennis Championships .
- It was the second consecutive Wimbledon singles title for Carlos Alcaraz and first Wimbledon singles title for Barbosa Krejcikova.
- It is the **third Grand Slam event of a calendar year** after the Australian Open and the French Open.

- This was the **fourth Grand Slam singles** title for **Alcaraz** having won the **French Open in 2024, the US Open in 2022** and **Wimbledon in 2023 and 2024**.
- Novak Djokovic holds the record of winning the maximum number of Grand Slam singles titles. He has won 24 singles titles.
- Second Grand Slam Singles Title for Barbora Krejcikova.
- Barbora Krejcikova of the Czech Republic won her second Grand Slam singles title after beating Jasmine Paolini of Italy in the final of the 2024 Wimbledon Championship.

• The Indian badminton players dominated the 3rd BWF Saint-Denis Reunion Open 2024 by winning both the men's and women's singles titles. Tharun Mannepalli of Telangana won the men's singles title by defeating Yudai Okimoto of Japan. Women's badminton single player Tasnim Mir of Gujarat defeated Rakshitha Sree of India

• The International Cricket Council (ICC) has revealed the winners of the ICC Player of the Month awards for June 2024 with India's Jasprit Bumrah and Smriti Mandhana both emerging victorious.

• The Indian Olympic Association (IOA) has named Gagan Narang as the Chefde-Mission of the Indian contingent to compete in the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, starting on 26th July.

• India's Dhruv Sitwala has won the men's Asian Billiards Championships after defeating Pankaj Advani in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia

• In the lead-up to the Paris Olympics, India's two-time Olympian Vinesh Phogat won the gold medal in the women's 50 kg category in the Grand Prix of Spain international continental wrestling championship.

• The 133rd Durand Cup matches will be held in Kolkata, Kokrajhar (Assam), Jamshedpur (Jharkhand), and Shillong (Meghalaya). For the first time, Jamshedpur will host the Durand Cup matches.

• India emerged as the top-performing nation at the Under 23 Asian Wrestling Championship 2024 in Amman, Jordan. Indian wrestlers secured a total of eight medals in freestyle wrestling: four gold, two silver, and two bronze.

• India's Jyothi Yarraji has won gold medal in the Women's 100m Hurdles at the National Inter State Senior Athletics Championships in Panchkula. While in Men's 110m Hurdles, Tejas Shirse won the gold medal.

• Former world chess champion Viswanathan Anand of India has won the Leon Master chess championship for the 10th time.

• India concluded their campaign at the Under-17 Asian Wrestling Championships in Amman, Jordan, on a resounding note. The young Indian contingent clinched a total of 11 medals, including four gold, two silver, and five bronze medals.

• Sreeja Akula of Hyderabad became the first Indian table tennis player to win a WTT (World Table Tennis) Contender Women's single title.

• In the Archery World Cup Stage 3, Dhiraj Bommadevara won the bronze in the men's individual recurve event as well as in the mixed team event with Bhajan Kaur, in Antalya, Turkey

• Carlos Alcaraz clinched his first French Open title, making him the youngest male tennis player to win Grand Slam titles on all three surfaces: hard, grass, and clay

• The 48th edition of the Copa America football tournament kick off in the United States.

• India's highest-rated chess player GM Arjun Erigaisi continued his top run as he dominated the 10-player field to win the Stepan Avagyan Memorial 2024 in Jermuk, Armenia , with a round to spare.

• Olympic medalist Indian boxer Lovlina Borgohain secured a silver medal in the Grand Prix 2024 competition held in the Czech Republic.

• India opener Smriti Mandhana etched her name into the history book by becoming the second-highest run-scorer for the nation.

• In the women's category, Chamari Athapaththu of Sri Lanka has been named the ICC Women's Player of the Month for May 2024.

• Gudakesh Motie of the West Indies as the ICC Men's Player of the Month for May 2024.

• India will host next year's men's Junior Hockey World Cup, the Executive Board of the International Hockey Federation announced.

• In athletics, India's Gulveer Singh has clinched the silver medal in the Men's 5000-metre race at the Portland Track Festival HighPerformance Meet in Portland, US.

• Saurabh Sharma, an athlete from Himachal Pradesh's Hamirpur district, has won two gold medals in the ongoing World Para Athlete Grand Prix in the Nottwil city of Switzerland.

• Dutch-Belgian racing driver Max Verstappen of Red Bull has won the Canadian Grand Prix 2024. Verstappen's triumph at the Canadian Grand Prix 2024 marked his 60th Formula 1 win and his sixth victory in nine races this season.

• The Indian men's tennis player Sumit Nagpal won the men's singles title at the Heilbronn Neckarcup 2024 ATP Challenger Tennis tournament in Germany.

• Indian shooter Sarabjot Singh won the gold medal in the men's 10m air pistol event at the ISSF World Cup 2024 in Munich, Germany.
