- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has given the Bengaluru-based investment management company Capitalmind Financial Services Private Limited preliminary approval to introduce a new mutual fund.
- At the moment, Capitalmind serves as a portfolio manager, overseeing assets under management (AUM) worth over Rs.2,200 crore for over 1,150 clients. The company keeps a solid 98% yearly client retention rate.
- Capitalmind, under the direction of Deepak Shenoy, is ranked 25th in India's AUM for discretionary equities strategies.
- Capitalmind has merged with other asset management companies (AMCs) based in Bengaluru, including Groww Mutual Fund, Zerodha Fund House, and Navi Mutual Fund.
- As of March 31, 2024, there are 74.6 crore PAN card holders in India, but only 4.5 crore unique mutual fund investors, highlighting significant untapped potential in the mutual fund market.

- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), a market regulator, has suggested amending the rules pertaining to debenture trustees (DTs).
- SEBI, which oversees the securities market, has suggested adding a new class of financial instruments to the securities market in order to expand the sustainable financing framework.
- Property Share became the 1st Fractional Ownership Platform (FOP) to receive India's 1st Small and Medium Real Estate Investment Trust (SM REIT) license from SEBI under the newly notified SM REIT regulations.
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) launched India's first website for passive funds at the National Stock Exchange (NSE), along with unveiling a comprehensive report on the Indian Capital Markets.
- Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has directed Mutual Funds (MFs) to value their investment in the Additional Tier-1 (AT-1) bonds issued by banks on Yield-to-Call (YTC) basis.
- Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has notified November 1, 2024 as the effective date for the implementation of insider trading rules aimed at enhancing the integrity and transparency within asset management companies (AMCs).
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) addressed recent media reports inaccurately claiming that it was considering making the T+0 settlement cycle mandatory for all transactions.
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has proposed a series
  of near-term measures to prevent speculative trading, such as gambling in
  index derivatives, which include curbing multiple option contract expiries
  and increasing the size of options contracts.
- SEBI has introduced SEBI's Virtual Assistant (SEVA) chatbot to help investors of the securities market.
- SEBI has reduced the deliverable period for commodity derivatives from the previous 5 days to 3 days. This regulatory change is set to take effect from July 1, 2024.
- SEBI has increased the limit for the Basic Service Demat Account (BSDA) to Rs 10 lakhs from the current Rs 2 lakhs to encourage small investors to participate in the securities market.

- SEBI has launched SCORES 2.0, an upgraded version of its Complaint Redress System (SCORES), to strengthen mechanisms for addressing investor complaints.
- LIC to meet regulatory requirements, the SEBI has extended LIC's deadline to achieve a minimum 10% public shareholding.
- SEBI has decided to decrease the minimum issue size for public issuance of Zero Coupon Zero Principal Instruments (ZCZP) from Rs 1 crore to Rs 50 lakh.
- National Stock Exchange (NSE) gets the final SEBI approval to launch Social Stock Exchange.
- SEBI has granted approval to CRISIL ESG Ratings & Analytics as a
  Category 1 provider of ESG ratings, marking a significant development
  in the realm of environmental, social, and governance (ESG) assessments
  in India.

- India launched its first reusable hybrid rocket, named RHUMI-1.
- Space Zone India, a start-up based in Tamil Nadu, worked with the Martin Group to develop the rocket. The rocket was launched from Chennai, India's Thiruvidandhai.
- Three Cube satellites were deployed by RHUMI-1 to monitor and gather data on atmospheric conditions, such as air quality, UV and cosmic radiation intensities.
- In order to investigate several atmospheric factors like vibration, accelerometer readings, altitude, ozone levels, and hazardous content, it also launched fifty Pico satellites.
- Data will be gathered by these satellites to aid in the study of climate change and global warming.
- The mission, known as Mission RHUMI 2024, is led by Anand Megalingam, the founder of Space Zone India.

- Mylswamy Annadurai, a former project director of India's Moon Mission "Chandrayaan" and director of the ISRO Satellite Centre (ISAC), is serving as the project's mentor.
- RHUMI-1 has an electrically activated parachute deployer and a hybrid motor powered by generic fuel. It contains 0% TNT and is completely free of fireworks.
- For increased effectiveness and lower operating costs, the rocket blends liquid and solid fuel propellant systems.

 The Deen Dayal SPARSH Yojana was started by the Department of Post, which is part of the Union Ministry of Communication, to encourage student research and scholarship in stamps throughout the nation.

#### **About the Deen Dayal SPARSH Yojana:**

- A recognized school's class VI, VII, VIII, and IX students are eligible to apply for the Deen Dayal SPARSH (Scholarship for Promotion of Aptitude & Research in Stamps as a Hobby) Yojana, which is an all-India program.
- A maximum of 40 scholarships may be given to 10 students from each of Standard VI, VII, VIII, and IX by each postal circle in the nation.
- The scholarship will be awarded weekly and costs Rs 6000 annually.
- The scholarship will only be awarded to students who have a Philately Deposit Account or are members of a Philately group.

- 920 scholarships for students who pursue philately as a pastime will be given out at all India levels.
- Students who meet the Yojana's requirements can apply again the following year. Scholarship selections are made for a period of one year.
- Philately is the study and collection of postal stamps and associated items. Philately is the pastime of collecting stamps and the related objects that are acquired, arranged, cataloged, stored, displayed, and maintained in themed spaces.

- The Unified Pension System (UPS) for its employees has been approved by the Union Cabinet, which is led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The current National Pension System (NPS) will be replaced with the new plan Unified Pension System (UPS).
- With the exception of the military forces, which enlisted on January 1, 2004, all central government employees were required to participate in the National Pension System. Afterwards, the NPS was introduced for employees by numerous state governments.
- The Indian government has planned to adopt the Unified Pension Scheme from April 1, 2025.
- A certain pension amount is provided by the UPS, guaranteeing pensioners a regular, predetermined amount after retirement.
- If you work with UPS for 25 years or more, you will be eligible for a pension that is equal to 50% of your average income from the previous 12 months, with inflation adjusted by dearness allowance.
- Under the UPS, employee contributions won't change. That is Employees are to contribute 10% of their salary. The government will, however, upend its 14% contribution to 18.5%.

- You will get a lump sum payment at superannuation combined with a gratuity when you leave from UPS.
- For each six months of completed service, this will be equal to one-tenth of your monthly emoluments (pay + DA) on the day of superannuation. The guaranteed pension amount will not be lowered by this payment.
- After at least 25 years of qualifying service, retirees under UPS will earn 50% of their average basic pay for the final 12 months prior to retirement.
- Pensions for shorter service durations will be equivalent and require a minimum of ten years of service. At least ten years of service will be required before receiving a pension of Rs 10,000 per month.

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- Bhupendra Rajnikant Patel, Chief Minister of Gujarat, launched the 'Shramik Basera' scheme.
- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu launched the NTR Bharosa pension scheme

- There are just two districts in Ladakh at the moment: Leh and Kargil. The
  autonomous district councils that oversee both districts are in charge.
  Ladakh will have seven districts overall after the additional ones are
  created.
- Ladakh was a component of the former state of Jammu and Kashmir until 2019. But that year, the state's special status was abolished by the BJP-led Central government. Additionally, the state was split into two union territories by the government: Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.

- Scooters manufactured by Ola Electric, model numbers S1 X 3 kWh and S1 X 4 kWh, have been certified as complying with the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for the automotive and auto component industries.
- The Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) certified Ola Electric after the company fulfilled the Ministry of Heavy Industries' minimum localization requirement of 50%.
- For a maximum of five consecutive fiscal years beginning with Fiscal 2024, the company is eligible to receive incentives ranging from 13% to 18% of the determined sales value of conforming products.
- Ola Electric is now the only manufacturer of EVs to have PLI compliance certification for four of its models: the 3 kWh and 4 kWh S1 Air, S1 Pro, and S1 X models. Earlier, at the January 2024 Auto PLI Conclave, the S1 Air was certified by PLI.

#### **About Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme:**

- With a budgetary commitment of INR 25,938 crore, the government introduced the PLI program in 2021 with the goal of increasing local manufacturing of Advanced automobile Technology (AAT) goods and luring investments into the automobile manufacturing value chain.
- By offering financial incentives to automakers and component manufacturers, the program focuses on Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEVs), such as Battery Electric and Hydrogen Fuel Cell Vehicles.

- One of the main election promises made by the BJP, which took power by unseating former Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik's 24-year tenure, is the Subhadra program.
- From the fiscal year 2024–2025 until the fiscal year 2028–2029, the Scheme may be implemented. For this endeavor, Rs.55,825 crore has been allocated.
- Over one crore women in the State would have their lives completely changed by Subhadra. All qualified women who are under 60 years old and have reached the age of 21 will be covered.
- The annual amount of 210,000 will be paid in two payments of 25,000 on March 8th, International Women's Day, and Rakhi Purnima Day.

- The Kakrapar Atomic Power Station (KAPS) in Gujarat, India, has reached full operational capacity with its second 700 MW nuclear reactor, KAPS 4.
- This achievement follows the reactor's commercial operation starting on March 31, 2024, and its first criticality on December 17, 2023.
- The Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) confirmed that Unit 4 at KAPS was previously operating at 90% capacity before reaching its full 700 MW output.
- NPCIL is advancing its nuclear energy capabilities with 14 additional reactors of the same design planned for completion by 2031-2032.
- Presently, NPCIL operates 24 reactors totaling 8,180 MW, with eight more reactors under construction and ten additional reactors in preproject phases.
