- Currently, 36 lenders, including banks and NBFCs, use over 50 data services including authentication, land records from 6 states, satellite data, property searches, dairy insights, and document verification.
- The RBIH created the Public Tech Platform for Frictionless Credit to provide a digital solution for agriculture loans.


















## **Explanation:**

- Unified Payments Interface (UPI) transactions increased by 8% month on month to 16.73 billion in December, the greatest number for the digital system since its launch in April 2016.
- The value also rose by 8% to Rs 23.25 trillion, up from Rs 21.55 trillion in November.
- According to figures from the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), the volume of transactions climbed by 46% to around 172 billion in 2024, up from 118 billion in 2023.
- In terms of value, transactions climbed by 35% to roughly Rs 247 trillion for the year, compared to Rs 183 trillion in 2023.
- Compared to November, the number of daily transactions climbed from 516 million to 540 million in December.
- This resulted in an increase in daily value to Rs 74,990 crore from Rs 71,840 crore in November.
- The volume and value in December increased by 39% and 28%, respectively, compared to December 2023.

- This streamlined approach is intended to make the procedure more efficient and comfortable for NRIs.
- Indian financial institutions offer an NRI bank account, which is a bespoke banking solution for Indian residents or Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) residing overseas.
- These accounts provide a variety of banking services to help NRIs manage their financial affairs, investments, and transactions within India.
- NRE Account are Non-Resident External account for managing income earned outside India
- NRO Account are Non-Resident Ordinary account for income earned in India.



- It began microfinance activity in 2006 and was registered with the RBI as an NBFC-MFI in September 2013.
- VFS makes loans to individual female members, primarily from rural areas, through joint liability groups (JLGs) of five members each. VFS Capital makes all disbursements digitally.


- The Union Cabinet, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has approved the extension of the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana and Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme until 2025-26, with a total budget of Rs.69,515.71 crore from 2021-22 to 2025-26.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the creation of the Fund for Innovation and Technology (FIAT) with a capital of Rs.824.77 Crore to enhance transparency and claim calculation and settlement in the scheme's execution.
- The fund will support technological efforts such as Yield Estimation System using Technology (YESTECH), Weather Information and Network Data Systems (WINDS), and research and development.
- YES-TECH: Uses remote sensing technology to estimate yield accurately; it has now been deployed in nine key states, including Madhya Pradesh, which will use 100% technology-based estimating in 2023-24.
- WINDS: Plans to build up Automatic meteorological Stations (AWS) and Automatic Rain Gauges (ARGs) to collect hyper-local meteorological data. The system is being implemented in nine states, including Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka, with a funding ratio of 90:10 between the central and state governments.




## **Recent News Headlines Related to Schemes**

- The Income Tax Department has extended the deadline for the Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme 2024, offering taxpayers another chance to resolve disputes at lower tax rates. The extended new date is January 31, 2025.
- The Haryana government has agreed to enhance the maximum amount of Deathcum-Retirement Gratuity for state government employees by 25%.
- Government of India(GoI) sanctioned Rs. 4388 crore under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) Scheme to solarize agriculture for states across India.
- Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) chief Arvind Kejriwal has launched a new scholarship programme aimed at Dalit students in Delhi. The scheme, named the Dr Ambedkar Samman Scholarship, will cover all expenses for Dalit students wishing to pursue higher education abroad.
- Delhi Chief Minister Atishi has introduced the Mukhyamantri Mahila Samman Yojana, which would pay a monthly stipend of Rs 1,000 to women residents with annual household incomes of up to Rs 3 lakh.
- Gujarat, Maharashtra, and Uttar Pradesh have emerged as the top three states for rooftop solar installations under the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana plan. It is launched on February 15, 2024.



















- West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has launched the "Banglar Bari" initiative, which aims to provide housing for the state's rural poor.
- Yuva Shuddhi Abhiyan Launched by Karnataka Governor Thaawarchand Gehlot to raise awareness about the dangers of drug abuse among youth.
- The Chief Minister introduced 'Him Bhog Atta,' which is prepared from maize harvested by farmers in Uttarakhand using natural agricultural practices.
- The Indira Gandhi Sukh Shiksha Yojna aims to prevent child exploitation and assist vulnerable children of widows, poor mothers, divorced women, and disabled parent.
- The Chief Minister handed over keys to 16 electric taxi owners as part of the Rajiv Gandhi Self-Employment Start-up Scheme 2023.
- The Government of India's main effort for people with disabilities (PwDs), Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan or Accessible India Campaign (AIC), has been successfully implemented for 9 years.
- The Empowered Programme Committee has approved 7 startup proposals under the GREAT scheme. The Government is providing a maximum fund support of Rs 50 lakhs per startup.
- The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) predicts that by March 2025, rooftop solar installations under the PM Surva Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSGMBY) will exceed 10 lakh.

- Total exports in 2023-24 increased by 12.22% to \$1.28 billion.
- Major export markets include Italy, Russia, the UAE, Germany, and Turkey.
- Brazil is the Largest coffee grower and Rank of India as coffee grower is 8th.
- Coffee produces by India are Arabica and Robusta (72% of India's production). India is the 5th largest Robusta producer globally (Vietnam is largest).





- The institute and the agriculture ministry have signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to supplement the Vistaar platform with information about agricultural startups and related sectors.
- This will make farmers and others in the agricultural and allied industries more aware of startups' skills and opportunities.


















- IIT Madras has completed a 410-meter Hyperloop test track, marking a big step forward in India's pursuit of futuristic transportation solutions.
- Hyundai Motor Group has partnered with three IITs to build a joint research system in the domains of batteries and electrification, involving a USD 7 million investment over five years.
- IIT Guwahati will host the 10th India International Science Festival (IISF) 2024 from November 30 to December 3.
- Samsung R&D Institute, Noida (SRI-Noida) has signed a MOU with the famed Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IIT Bombay).
- IIT Madras and ISRO Collaborate to create a Centre of Excellence focused on research in 'Fluid and Thermal Sciences'. ISRO will provide seed funding of Rs 1.84 Crore to establish this center.
- The IIT Madras aims to establish a worldwide flagship center in Dubai to promote research, innovation, and entrepreneurship.
- IIT Delhi and the International Energy Agency (IEA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding on clean energy transition.
- IIT Indore has developed a new technology for early detection of breast cancer that is specifically geared to assist women in rural and remote places.
- IIT Delhi and the Indian Air Force's Headquarters Maintenance (HQ) Command in Nagpur have signed a MOU to collaborate on the development of novel technologies for aviation textiles, with an emphasis on parachutes and other safety equipment.
- US Government Partner with IIT Madras Research Park in Chennai to work in 4 broad areas namely, Solar energy (SE), Green Hydrogen (GH), Electric Vehicles (EVs), and Batteries, and Green Buildings (GBs).

- The first group includes Reserve Bank of India-approved prepaid instruments such as gift cards and digital wallets. These vouchers are treated as'money' under the GST structure, thus transactions using them are not categorized as the supply of goods or services.
- The second group includes non-prepaid vouchers, which are not classified as prepaid instruments. These vouchers function as claims for certain goods or services and are classified as 'actionable claims'. These transactions, like their prepaid counterparts, do not count as a supply of goods or services for GST purposes.
- The CBIC stated that, regardless of the form of voucher, transactions involving vouchers will not be considered the supply of goods or services. However, the items or services that can be redeemed with these vouchers may still be liable to GST.
- Regarding unused vouchers, when vouchers go unused after their expiry date, known as breakage, the money from these unredeemed vouchers is not taxable under GST.

- At the aggregate level, we predict India's poverty rates could presently be in the range of 4% to 4.5 percent, with nearly no extreme poverty.
- The dramatic drop in the rural poverty ratio is due to increased consumption growth in the lowest 0-5 percent decile, with significant government support.
- According to the 2023-24 fractile distribution, the sample share of poverty in rural areas is 4.86 percent, whereas 4.09 percent in urban areas in FY24. This is also much lower than the FY23 predictions for rural poverty (7.2%) and urban poverty (4.6%).
- The difference between rural and urban monthly per capita consumption expenditure (MPCE) is now at 69.7 per cent, a rapid decline from 88.2 per cent in 2009-10.
