
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated the 13-kilometer extension of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Namo Bharat route.

- Notable stations include Sarai Kale Khan, Anand Vihar, Sahibabad, and Meerut South.
- The corridor will feature India's fastest rapid transit trains, known as Namo Bharat, which can travel at speeds of up to 160 km/h. These trains are intended to cut the travel time between Delhi and Meerut to around an hour.
- The ticket from New Ashok Nagar Station to Meerut South is Rs 150 for a regular coach and Rs 225 for a premium coach.

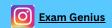




- Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the BHARATPOL platform, designed by the Central Bureau of Investigation, in New Delhi.









Recent News headlines related to Sports

- Koneru Humpy, an Indian Grandmaster, won his second World Rapid Chess Championship, this time in New York. Koneru Humpy, 37, won the title by defeating Irene Sukandar with black pieces in the final round.

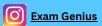



- Jose Andres: A renowned Spanish-American culinary innovator who popularized tapas in the United States.
- Tim Gill: visionary entrepreneur whose work has advanced LGBTQI rights and equality.
- Bono: frontman for legendary rock band U2 and a pioneering activist against AIDS and poverty.
- Hillary Rodha Clinton: made history many times over decades in public service, including as the first First Lady elected to the United States Senate.

















- Jane Goodall: world-renowned ethologist and conservationist whose research transformed our understanding of primates and human evolution
- Ralph Lauren: fashion designer who redefined the fashion industry with a lifestyle brand that embodies timeless elegance and American tradition
- Fannie Lou Hamer (posthumous): transformed the struggle for racial justice in **America**
- Robert Francis Kennedy (posthumous): remembered as an Attorney General who fiercely combatted racial segregation, and as a United States Senator who sought to address poverty and inequality in the country.
- Lionel Messi: most decorated player in the history of professional soccer.
- Earvin "Magic" Johnson: legendary retired basketball player who led the Los Angeles Lakers to five championships.
- George W. Romney (posthumous): businessman who served as the chairman and president of American Motors Corporation.
- Denzel Washington: an actor, director, and producer who has won two Academy Awards, a Tony Award, two Golden Globes, and the 2016 Cecil B. DeMille Lifetime Achievement Award.
- William Sanford Nye: inspired and influenced generations of American students as "Bill Nye the Science Guy."

- Chidambaram was born in Chennai in 1936 to C Rajagopal Aiyar, a Controller of Defence Accounts, and Ananthalakshmi.
- He graduated first at Madras University with a B.Sc (Honours). He later joined the Indian Institute of Science in Bengaluru in 1956, earning his master's degree in a year and his PhD in 1961.
- Though Chidambaram's name is mainly linked with Pokhran-II (India's second nuclear testing, in May 1998), he did play a significant role in the 1974 Pokhran-I, for which he received the Padma Shri award in 1975 and the Padma Vibhushan in 1999.

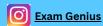


