- Eligible Lenders (MLIs): Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCBs), NBFCs (Non-Banking Financial Companies), and All India Financial Institutions (AIFIs) registered with NCGTC can provide loans under this scheme.
- Eligible Borrowers: The borrower must be an MSME with a valid Udyam Registration Number.
- Minimum Investment in Equipment: At least 75% of the total project cost should be used to buy machinery or equipment.


















Loan Repayment Terms:

- Loans up to Rs.50 crore: Repayment period of up to 8 years, with a 2-year moratorium (no principal payments for 2 years).
- Loans above Rs.50 crore: May get a longer repayment period and moratorium, based on approval.

Fees & Charges:

• Upfront Contribution: MSMEs must deposit 5% of the loan amount at the time of application.

Annual Guarantee Fee:

- No fee in the first year.
- 1.5% per year for the next 3 years.
- 1% per year after that.

Scheme Duration:

- The scheme is available for 4 years from the date the guidelines are issued OR until guarantees worth Rs.7 lakh crore have been issued-whichever comes first.
- This initiative is part of the 2024-25 Budget and aims to make credit more accessible for MSMEs, helping them grow and contribute to India's economy.





















