
- The Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) was upgraded from the existing NPS implemented on January 1, 2004 by the Atal Bihari Vajpayee government.
- Central government employees will have to contribute 10% of their basic salary and Dearness Allowance (DA).
- The central government boosted their contribution from 14% (under NPS) to 18.5%.
- Maharashtra was the first state to implement UPS for government employees, beginning March 2024.


















Key Rules for Assured Pension under UPS:

- All central government employees who have served for minimum 25 years, will receive 50% of their last drawn salary from the past 12 months before superannuation as pension
- The pension will be proportionate for those with shorter service periods (less than 25 years) of qualifying service, based on their service time
- The family of the deceased employee will be eligible to receive 60% of the pension amount that employee was receiving immediately before his death
- The policy offers an assured minimum pension of Rs 10,000 per month for employees who have served for at least 10 years on superannuation.
- UPS subscribers will get a lump sum payout of 10% of their monthly earnings (pay + DA) upon retirement, in addition to gratuity, for every 6 months of service completed.





















- An integrated dashboard provides exporters with easy access to eCoO services, FTA information, trade events, and other resources.
- As of January 1, 2025, the electronic filing of Non-Preferential Certificates of Origin has become mandatory via the eCoO 2.0 website, which exporters can access under the "Get Certificate of Origin" section.
- This trade facilitation program has streamlined the certification process and reduced turnaround times for exporters, indicating a considerable improvement in the Ease of Doing Business.




