
- The Union Cabinet has approved a new Brownfield Ammonia-Urea Complex at Brahmaputra Valley Fertilizer Corporation Limited (BVFCL) in Namrup, Assam, with an annual production capacity of 12.7 lakh metric tonnes (LMT).
- The project will be performed under a Joint Venture (JV) with a 70:30 Debt-Equity ratio at a cost of ₹10,601.40 crore, following the New Investment Policy, 2012 and its 2014 revisions. The completion timetable is 48 months
- National Fertilizers Limited (NFL) has been granted an 18% equity participation, which exceeds the guidelines set by the Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), and the project will be overseen by an Inter-Ministerial Committee.
- The Government of Assam owns 40% of the equity, BVFCL owns 11%, National Fertilizers Limited (NFL) and Oil India Limited (OIL) each own 18%, and Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Limited (HURL) owns 13%.
- The project intends to increase domestic urea production, benefiting North-East India, Bihar, West Bengal, Eastern Uttar Pradesh, and Jharkhand, while also improving energy efficiency and creating job opportunities.

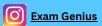

- Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, Anupriya Patel, has opened the India Innovation Summit - Pioneering Solutions to End Tuberculosis at the Bharat Mandapam Convention Centre.
- The Department of Health Research-Indian Council of Medical Research (DHR-ICMR) and the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare's Central TB Division (CTD) collaborated to organize the Summit. The conference intends to accelerate India's efforts toward TB elimination by 2025.
- The Program is consistently working toward its aim of eliminating tuberculosis by 2025. The number of missing cases has been reduced from 15 lakh in 2015 to 2.5 lakh by 2023.
- The program was able to notify 25.5 lakh tuberculosis and 26.07 lakh cases in 2023 and 2024, the highest ever.
- A shorter and safer oral Bedaquiline-containing drug resistant TB treatment regimen has been implemented throughout all states/UTs, increasing treatment success rates for drug-resistant TB patients from 68% in 2020 to 75% by 2022.




