- Separately, India and the Netherlands explored possibilities to use Dutch expertise for enhancing cargo movement in low-draft rivers like Brahmaputra and Barak, supporting inland water transport.





- He later became the world heavyweight champion twice, the second time at the age of 45 in 1994.
























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

In Gymnastics, India's Pranati Nayak has bagged the bronze medal in the Women's Vault final at the Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique (FIG) World Cup in Antalya, Turkey.

Ashok Singh Thakur has been elected the new chairman of the Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH) for a three-year term. INTACH, a leading historical conservation organisation based in Delhi, was founded in 1984.

East Coast Railway (ECoR) is the first railway zone in India to reach 250 million tons (MT) of originating freight in fiscal year 2024-25.

For the second year in a row, East Coast Railway (ECoR) has exceeded 250 metric tons. ECoR has surpassed 200 MT of freight loading for the sixth straight year.

India has recorded the highest-ever growth in indigenous defence manufacturing in 2023-24 since the commencement of the Make in India project, with a record one lakh 27 thousand crore rupees. The value of defence manufacturing has increased by 174%, from 46 thousand 429 crore in 2014-15.
















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
