- Jio Payment Bank is a joint venture between Jio Financial Service Limited and SBI, which began operations in April 2018.
- Jio Financial Services Limited owns 82.17% of Jio Payments Bank Limited's paid-up equity share capital, with SBI holding 17.8% of the shares.








- At the time of the announcement, the total value of high-denomination notes in circulation was Rs.3.56 lakh crore.
- As of February 28, 2025, this figure has dramatically fallen to Rs.6,471 crore.










- On March 5th, 2025, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced open market purchases of government assets and USD/INR swaps totaling Rs 1.9 lakh crore to boost banking liquidity.
- The central bank announced two Open Market Operations (OMO) purchase auctions for Government of India securities worth Rs 1 lakh crore.
- The auctions will be conducted in two parts: Rs 50,000 crore on March 12, 2025, and another Rs 50,000 crore on March 18, 2025.
- The RBI will hold a USD/INR Buy/Sell Swap auction for Rs 10 billion with a 36-month duration on March 24, 2025.
- The Indian banking system is experiencing its worst liquidity crisis in ten years, with a surplus of Rs 1.35 lakh crore in November and a shortfall of Rs 0.65 lakh crore by December.
- The deficit has increased to Rs 2.07 lakh crore in January and Rs 1.59 lakh crore in February.
- Since late 2024, the RBI has added almost Rs 3 lakh crore of durable liquidity to the system through VRR auctions, swaps, and open market operations.

- SEBI introduced the system in beta form as an optional feature on January 1, 2024.
- This framework keeps funds in bank accounts and debits them only when trades are executed. Payouts follow a T+1 settlement cycle.

About UPI trading blocks:

- UPI Trading Blocks, also known as Single Block Multiple Debits, enable investors to approve fund blocking straight from their bank accounts while making trade requests through brokerage apps.
- The functionality removes the need for multiple UPI PIN entry and increases flexibility by keeping cash available till needed.

- Over the course of two years, Project Dolphin performed an 8,500-kilometer survey of dolphin populations throughout the Ganga, Brahmaputra, and Indus rivers.
- The Wildlife Institute of India, state forest departments in Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Assam, Jharkhand, and Rajasthan, as well as non-profit organizations such as Aaranyak, World Wildlife Fund, Turtle Survival Alliance, and Wildlife Trust of India, collaborated on the survey, which ran from 2021 to 2023.






- Launched: Interim Budget 2019, A voluntary and contributory pension scheme
- Fund Manager: Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC)
- Contribution: GoI will match the contribution of workers on a 1:1 basis
- A minimum pension of Rs 3,000 per month after the age of 60 for workers who are employed in the unorganised sector and have a monthly income of up to Rs 15,000
- However, the contribution amount (Rs 55 to Rs 200), differs based on the age at the time of enrolment for instance: if the age of worker at entry is 18 years, then, he/she is required to make monthly contribution of Rs 55 and GoI will also contribute exactly the same amount
- The beneficiary passes away after the age of 60, only the spouse is entitled to receive 50% of the pension amount as a family pension
- Minimum age required for workers to enroll in the scheme should be 18 years and not be more than 40 years.







- This collaboration is part of a bigger push to expand defense ties between India and Belgium, with both nations aiming to sign a defense cooperation pact by the end of 2025.
- In this JV, JCD will own 60% while EPH will keep 40%. JCD will offer the technology, and EPH will handle the manufacturing. According to JCD's CEO, Thierry Renaudin, the project's goal is to build a world-class turret, with at least 50% of the components manufactured in India.







- The ship will be transferred from Port Blair to Karwar for component removal before being sunk near Nivati Rocks in Sindhudurg.



- The award ceremony will be held this spring at the Louvre Abu Dhabi, designed by Jean Nouvel.





- India's Aditya-L1 mission photographed a one-of-a-kind solar flare. The probe captured the first-ever photograph of a solar flare 'kernel.'
- This uncommon observation occurred in the lower solar atmosphere.
- Aditya-L1 was launched on September 2, 2023. On January 6, 2024, it entered a unique orbit. This orbit, known as Lagrange Point L1, is 1.5 million kilometers from Earth.
- Aditya-L1 may continuously monitor the Sun from here.
- Aditya-L1 carries modern instruments for studying the Sun. The Solar Ultraviolet Imaging Telescope (SUIT) contributed significantly to the discovery.
- SUIT detected the solar flare in the Near Ultraviolet (NUV) band. It can collect photos over 11 distinct wavelengths.
- Other equipment, including SoLEXS and HEL1OS, focus on studying solar Xrays. On February 22, 2024, SUIT identified an X6.3-class solar flare.
- SUIT is a unique space telescope constructed by IUCAA in Pune and launched by ISRO, while Aditya-L1 is India's first dedicated solar space mission.


- The Government of India has introduced a modified Ethanol Interest Subvention Scheme to assist Cooperative Sugar Mills (CSMs) in converting their existing ethanol plants into multi-feedstock plants, allowing them to use grains like maize and damaged food grains (DFG) for ethanol production
- Gujarat is the national leader in mangrove afforestation, planting 19,020 hectares at a cost of about Rs 76 crore through the Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats and Tangible Incomes (MISHTI) initiative
- The government has modified the PM CARES plan to provide high-quality coaching to youngsters, including SC and OBC students. The free coaching system, introduced under the Sixth Five-Year Plan, has been updated to improve its effectiveness over time

- Recognizing Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY)'s impact, the Union Cabinet recommended its continuation, together with the Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS), until 2025-26, with a budget of Rs.69,515.71 crore.
- The Centre has inaugurated the 'Mutual Credit Guarantee Scheme for MSMEs', which was announced in the Union Budget 2025-26, to help micro, small, and medium-sized firms. The policy allows MSMEs to obtain collateral-free loans of up to Rs 100 crore for the purchase of plant, machinery, or equipment
- G-SAFAL (Gujarat Scheme for Antyodaya Families for Augmenting Livelihoods) Launched by Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel. Its aim is to uplift 50,000 Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) cardholder families across 25 talukas in 10 districts of Gujarat over the next five years.







- The newly established Madhav Tiger Reserve situated in Shivpuri district, Gwalior-Chambal area. It is 1,751 square kilometers in size, comprising 375 square kilometres of core area and 1,276 square kilometres of buffer zone.
- The newly established Madhav Tiger Reserve follows the recent recognition of Ratapani Wildlife Sanctuary, located between Bhopal and Raisen districts, as the state's eighth Tiger Reserve and 57th Tiger Reserve of India.
- Three tigers, two of which were females, were introduced to Madhav National Park in 2023 as part of the state's tiger reintroduction project.
- Other TRs in MP include Bandhavgarh, Kanha, Panna, Sanjay, Satpura, Pench, Veerangana Durgavati, and Ratapani Wildlife Sanctuary.
- Tiger Reserves are notified by state governments based on Section 38V of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and advice from the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA).


- Bhupender Yadav, the Union Minister for Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, notified the nation that the Ratapani Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh has been designated as the country's 57th Tiger Reserve.
- The 12th International Tourism Mart was held in Kaziranga National Park, Assam, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- The Chhattisgarh government has officially established Guru Ghasidas National Park and Tamor Pingla Wildlife Sanctuary as tiger reserves, bringing the total number of tiger reserves in the state to four.

- The forest department organised its first 'Cyclothon' recently to celebrate World Wildlife Week 2024 at the buffer zone of the Kawal Tiger Reserve in Telangana. Government of India declared Kawal Wildlife Sanctuary a Tiger Reserve in 2012.
- The Ratapani Sanctuary is stretching its arms to get the status of a tiger reserve. It is Situated in Raisen and Sehore districts of Madhya Pradesh, it spreads over 825.90 sq km.
- The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) has been told by forest officials at the Palamau Tiger Reserve that Naxals have invaded the area.
- 'Dark Sky Park' has made Pench Tiger Reserve in Maharashtra the first tiger reserve in India and the fifth in Asia.
- A cutting-edge artificial intelligence (AI) technology for the early detection of forest fires was recently introduced by Pench Tiger Reserve.
- By the end of the year, Bihar will have another tiger reserve, the Kaimur Wildlife Sanctuary, in the Kaimur district, following the Valmiki Tiger Reserve (VTR) in the West Champaran district.
- The creation of the Special Tiger Protection Force for the three Tiger Reserves in Arunachal Pradesh has been approved.
