• Additionally, a Rs.6 lakh penalty was added because Flipkart continued selling insurance policies even after applying for renewal of registration.

- Major powers like the USA, China, India, Israel, and Russia are not members.


Eligibility for the scheme is :

• Green clearance channels, lower bunker fuel GST, and a National Database for Coastal Shipping are among the provisions. According to the law, coastal freight traffic is expected to increase from 162 million tonnes in 2023–2024 to 230 million tonnes by 2030.





• This yearly celebration inspires people all throughout the world to oppose hate speech, prejudice, and violence and to advance the ideals of human rights, peace, and universal dignity.





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


