- RBI imposed a monetary penalty of Rs.29.60 lakh on Axis Bank Limited on April 29, 2025, for violating regulatory guidelines under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- The penalty was imposed due to unauthorised operations and unrelated entries in internal/office accounts.
- The action was based on findings from an inspection of the bank's financial position as of March 31, 2024 (ISE 2024).
- Relevant legal provisions invoked: Section 47A(1)(c) and 46(4)(i) of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- RBI clarified that the penalty pertains solely to regulatory compliance issues and does not question the validity of customer transactions or agreements.



















Recent Penalties imposed on Banks by RBI:


- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed monetary penalties on Indian Bank, Indian Overseas Bank, and Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services Ltd in 2025 for regulatory non-compliance.
- Indian Bank faced a fine of Rs.1.60 crore, Indian Overseas Bank was penalized Rs.63.60 lakh and Mahindra Finance received a penalty of Rs.71.30 lakh
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of Rs.29.60 lakh on Punjab National Bank (PNB) for violating its guidelines on Customer Service in Banks
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of Rs.38.60 lakh on IDFC First Bank for violating Know Your Customer (KYC) norms
- RBI imposed a Rs.36.40 lakh penalty on Aryavart Bank, Lucknow for not complying with regulatory norms
- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has imposed a Rs.1.06 crore fine on Flipkart Internet Pvt. Ltd. (FIPL)
- The RBI has imposed monetary penalties on KLM Axiva Finvest of Rs.10 lakh for not complying with dividend declaration requirements
- The RBI has imposed monetary penalties on Punjab & Sind Bank of Rs.68.2 lakh for not complying with regulatory guidelines
- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed a Rs.75 lakh penalty on HDFC Bank for noncompliance with KYC norms
- RBI imposed a monetary penalty of Rs.36.28 lakh on Citibank N.A. under Section 11(3) of FEMA, 1999
- RBI imposed a penalty of Rs.36.30 lakh on IDBI Bank under Section 11(3) of FEMA, 1999.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed penalties of Rs 66.60 lakh and Rs 33.10 lakh on The Hong Kong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited (HSBC) and IIFL Samasta Finance, respectively, for violating regulations

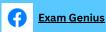

- As of April 30, 2025, Rs.6,266 crore worth of Rs.2000 notes remain in circulation, which is about 8.24% of the total value originally issued.
- 91.76% of the Rs.2000 notes have been returned to the banking system.
- The Rs.2000 banknotes continue to be legal tender, and their withdrawal process remains in place.
- The exchange of Rs.2000 notes is still available through 19 RBI Issue Offices and India Post.



- These lapses resulted in a cumulative loss of nearly Rs.1979 crore to the bank.

- 26 of the United States of America's trading partners, including India, were designated as nations of concern due to insufficient protection of the intellectual property rights of American goods and services.
- Every year, the US Congress must receive a report from the Office of the US Trade Representative (USTR) detailing the state of intellectual property rights protection for US goods abroad.
- The USTR looked into the nations that were on the Priority Watch List and Watch List in accordance with Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974.
- China, India, Indonesia, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Russia, and Venezuela are among the nations on the Priority Watch list.
- Algeria, Egypt, Barbados, Belarus, Paraguay, Turkey, Bolivia, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Colombia, Ecuador, Guatemala, Pakistan, Peru, Thailand, Trinidad and Tobago, and Vietnam are among the nations on the Watch list.

- Key features include geo-tagged uploads, AI-based bag counting, ANPR vehicle tracking, facial recognition access, and IoT sensors for fire, gas, and humidity monitoring.
- Each depot will receive a star rating based on infrastructure quality, stock turnover, loss management, and compliance.


















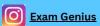
- The Income Tax Department launched the 'e-Pay Tax' feature on its official online portal
- To make land record management easier, more transparent, and more publically available, the Telangana government launched the Bhu Bharati portal
- Startup QNu Labs introduces Q-Shield, the first platform of its kind in the world that enables businesses to safeguard vital infrastructure
- Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal launched the dedicated digital portal developed by the Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) to facilitate private sector participation in building infrastructure (like jetties and terminals) on National Waterways, promoting Ease of Doing Business (EODB)

- The magnet is a key step toward building a reactor that could demonstrate the viability of fusion as a sustainable energy source for the future.




