





- The bank's strong position is attributed to a 31% CAGR in net profit over the last five years.
- Alphabet, the parent company of Google, tops the list with a profit of USD 111 billion, showing the strong earnings power of tech companies.
- Saudi Aramco comes next with USD 105 billion, proving that the energy sector continues to be very profitable
- With 43 companies, the United States of America (USA) tops the list, followed by China (19 companies) and Germany (5 companies).

- The national crude birth rate stood at 19.3 per 1,000 population in 2021.
- These southern and urbanized states are undergoing faster demographic transition, impacting future population, health, and employment policies.
- In contrast, states like Rajasthan (0.48%), Bihar (0.86%), and Chhattisgarh (0.98%) showed the slowest decline, while Uttarakhand was the only state to report an increase.

- Although the mission started in 2003, progress was limited until this major revamp.
- So far, 52 lakh manuscripts' metadata have been digitized, and over 3 lakh manuscripts preserved digitally, but only one-third are uploaded online.
- The government is also planning an autonomous body for better management of ancient texts.

- Second layer: Uses guided micro-missiles for accurate attacks on specific drones.






- Glacial loss accelerates global warming due to less albedo effect, contributes to sea-level rise, disrupts freshwater supply, and increases natural disaster risks like Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs) and avalanches.
- Other recently declared dead glaciers include Sarenne Glacier (France, 2023) and Pico Humboldt Glacier (Venezuela, 2024).
- The first glacier funeral was held for Okjokull Glacier in Iceland in 2019 (officially declared dead in 2014).

Prof. Ajay Kumar Sood, the Principal Scientific Advisor to the Government of India, launched the report on India's Priority Corridors for Zero Emission Trucking. The report identifies 10 critical highway corridors in India that are ideal for Zero-Emission Truck (ZET) deployment.

- The SPMCIL currency presses are located in Dewas, Central India, and Nasik, Western India. The two BRBNMPL presses are located in Salboni, Eastern India, and Mysore, Southern India.
- Coins are produced at four SPMCIL-owned mints. The mints may be found in NOIDA, Hyderabad, Kolkata, and Mumbai.
- According to Section 38 of the RBI Act, the coins can only be circulated by the Reserve Bank.
