
- The Safran Group has announced the creation of Safran Aircraft Engine Services India in Hyderabad, Telangana.



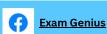

- 2. Lok Sabha Seats: Wins at least 2% of total Lok Sabha seats (i.e., 11 seats out of 543) and the candidates are elected from at least 3 different states
- 3. Vote Share + Seats in LS: Gets 6% of votes in 4 or more states in Lok Sabha or Assembly elections and wins 4 Lok Sabha seats


State Party - Criteria:

1. Vote Share + Seat : Gets at least 6% of valid votes in that state's Legislative Assembly election and wins 2 seats















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- 2. Lok Sabha Vote + Seat: Gets 6% votes in Lok Sabha election from that state and wins 1 seat in Lok Sabha
- 3. Seat Count in Assembly : Wins at least 3% of the total seats in the Legislative Assembly OR 3 seats (whichever is more)
- 4. Lok Sabha Seat Count: Wins 1 out of every 25 Lok Sabha seats from that state






