



- KredX also signed an MoU with the Ministry of MSME to integrate its platform with the Udyam registration database for broader access and efficiency.

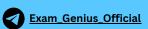
























- IRDAI has directed all life, general, and standalone health insurance companies to cover 75,000 Gram Panchayats over a two-year period.
- In FY 2025-26, insurers must cover 25,000 villages, and in FY 2026-27, this will increase to 50,000 Gram Panchayats.
- The minimum coverage target is 15% of lives/assets/vehicles per Gram Panchayat in FY26, rising to 25% in FY27 (10% for newly added Panchayats).
- This move is part of the rural, social sector, and motor third-party obligations to boost insurance inclusion in rural India.






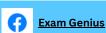

- Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) was founded in 1937, and its headquarters is in Chennai. The current MD & CEO of IOB is Ajay Kumar Srivastava.

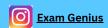


**Answer: Option C** 

- As per the Ministry of Finance, 1,629 unique corporate borrowers have been classified as wilful defaulters by public sector banks, with total outstanding loans of Rs.1.62 lakh crore as of March 31, 2025.
- Legal measures invoked include the SARFAESI Act, Debt Recovery Tribunals (DRTs), Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC), and criminal proceedings.
- Defaulters are denied additional credit and barred from launching new ventures for five years.
- The RBI's Master Directions require banks to share monthly lists of wilful defaulters (loan size ≥ Rs.25 lakh) with all Credit Information Companies (CICs).
- These lists are publicly available on platforms like CIBIL.
- The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has declared 9 individuals as Fugitive Economic Offenders, confiscating assets worth Rs.15,298 crore under PMLA and Rs.749 crore under FEOA 2018.
- Total Rs.25,806 crore has been restituted to victim banks and rightful claimants in bank fraud cases.

- PM Modi also became the second-longest serving Indian Prime Minister after Jawaharlal Nehru, completing 4,079 days in office.






- New provisions like Section 6AA and 6AB prohibit unauthorized recording and transmission of films.
- The amendment also introduced strict punishments minimum 3 months imprisonment and Rs.3 lakh fine, which can extend to 3 years imprisonment and fine up to 5% of the gross production cost.
- Section 7(1B)(ii) empowers the Government to issue directions to intermediaries hosting pirated content.








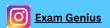
- The National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) launched 'Veer Parivar Sahayata Yojana', a scheme to strengthen legal aid for defence personnel and their families, during the North Zone Regional Conference held in Srinagar
- Under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY), state governments have defaulted over Rs.6,450 crore in crop insurance settlements between FY21 and FY25
- The Palna Scheme, launched on April 1, 2022, under the Samarthya vertical of Mission Shakti, aims to bridge the childcare gap. It provides day-care and crèche facilities for children aged 6 months to 6 years across all States and Union Territories
- As of March 2025, under the Jal Jeevan Mission, Uttar Pradesh has reported the highest number of rural household tap water connections with 237.89 lakh connections
- The second phase of the PM Internship Scheme (PMIS) will commence on August 1. The target for FY26 is 7 lakh interns, which is six times higher than the FY25 target
- 'Shaktishree' is a special initiative launched by the Odisha Government for the safety and well-being of girl students across 16 universities and 730 government and aided colleges under the Higher Education Department

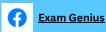

- Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre and the National Institute of Ocean Technology have signed an MoU for developing 'MATSYA-6000', a human-occupied submersible vessel.
- It is being developed under the 'Samudrayaan Project', which is part of India's Deep Ocean Mission led by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES).
- This mission aims to send a three-member crew up to a depth of 6,000 metres to explore deep-ocean resources.
- The submersible includes a 2,260 mm spherical personnel capsule made from Titanium alloy (Ti6Al4V - ELI grade) with 80 mm wall thickness, designed to endure extreme pressure (up to 600 bar) and cold temperatures (as low as -3°C).

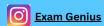
















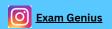
- Australia and the United Kingdom (UK) have signed a 50-year commitment to the AUKUS defence treaty despite the United States' ongoing review of the pact. It is a security and defense partnership between Australia, the UK, and the US, announced in September 2021.
- The India-UK trade deal allows duty-free access to a \$23 billion UK market, benefiting MSMEs across labour-intensive sectors
- As per the India-UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), 75,000 Indian skilled professionals will be allowed to work in the UK annually. They will be exempt from contributing to UK social security for 3 years
- The India-UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) grants 95% of Indian agricultural and processed food products duty-free access to the \$37.5 billion **UK** market
- Under the India-UK Free Trade Agreement (FTA), Araku Valley Coffee has received duty-free access to the United Kingdom market
- The Ministry of Defence (MoD) has signed a Rs.2,000 crore contract with Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) for the supply of Air Defence Fire Control Radars.
- India and the United Kingdom signed a Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) at Chequers Estate, UK.
- Maruti Suzuki India Limited & Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) to drive and support technology-driven solutions in automobile manufacturing and mobility space

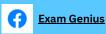

- This recognition highlights the global literary presence of Hindi and Indian regional languages.




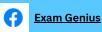


- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch three more navigation satellites – NVS-03, NVS-04, and NVS-05 – by 2026 to enhance IRNSS, also known as NavIC (Navigation with Indian Constellation).
- NavIC is India's independent regional navigation satellite system, developed by ISRO.
- The system covers India and a region extending up to 1500 km beyond its borders.
- NavIC includes a constellation of seven satellites: three in geostationary orbit (GSO) and four in inclined geosynchronous orbit (GEO).
- It ensures interoperability with other global navigation systems such as GPS, GLONASS, Galileo, and BeiDou.

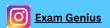
- NISAR (NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar) is the first joint satellite developed by NASA and ISRO
- ISRO successfully conducted two short-duration hot tests of the Gaganyaan Service Module Propulsion System (SMPS) at the ISRO Propulsion Complex (IPRC), Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu
- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) has signed a Rs.511 crore Transfer of Technology (ToT) deal with ISRO to manufacture and operate Small Satellite Launch Vehicles (SSLVs)

- Each train is estimated to cost rs.80 crore, while the infrastructure cost per route is Rs.70 crore.



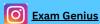




















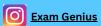
