


















- Fund houses can now incentivize distributors for bringing in new investors from beyond the top 30 cities (B-30 regions).
- For lumpsum investments, the incentive will be 1% of the first investment made by the investor.
- For Systematic Investment Plans (SIP), the incentive will be 1% of total investments in the first year, subject to a ceiling of ₹2,000.
- This new framework replaces the earlier structure, which was valid until March 2023.
- Under the previous system, MFs could charge up to 30 basis points (bps) over and above the expense ratio for assets coming from B-30 regions.
- The B-30 programme, first introduced in 2012, was discontinued by SEBI in February 2023.

- Sign & Ratification: Signed by 145 countries, ratified by 61 countries. Palau was the first to ratify on 22 Jan 2024, Morocco became the 60th. India signed on 25 Sep 2024 but has not ratified yet.
- The BBNJ agreement will come into force on 17 January 2026 and its implementation will be overseen by a Conference of the Parties (CO P)

- In the second phase, the EC de-listed 474 RUPPs on September 18 for not contesting elections continuously for six years.
- Total de-listed RUPPs in the last two months: 808 (334 + 474).
- After this de-listing, 2,046 RUPPs remain registered with the EC.
- Political parties are registered with the EC under Section 29A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.
- The EC has also identified 359 RUPPs that failed to submit their Annual Audited Accounts for the last three financial years (2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24) and did not file Election Expenditure Reports despite contesting elections.













- Previously, the holy relics have been taken to Mongolia (2022), Thailand (2024), and Vietnam (2025) for international expositions.




















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
