Recently signed banking agreements

- The Bank of Maharashtra has joined three other lenders—State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, and Bank of India—in labeling Reliance Communications' ₹488 crore loan as fraudulent, adding to the telecom company's financial troubles.
- The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, signed an MoU with Kotak Mahindra Bank Ltd. to enhance financial and non-financial support for startups across India.
- ICICI Bank has partnered with the Tata Memorial Centre (TMC) to build a new cancer care building named 'ICICI Foundation Block for Radiation Oncology' at ACTREC, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- Axis Bank, one of India's largest private sector banks, has partnered with Hitachi Payment Services to launch "Express Banking", the country's first Digital Banking Point.
- Bajaj Finserv AMC, in collaboration with fintech firm Curie Money, launched the 'Pay with Mutual Fund' feature, allowing investors to use their mutual fund units for UPI transactions.

- HSBC and Juspay Technologies Private Limited, a leading payments infrastructure company, collaborated to launch a first-of-its-kind acquiring platform tailored to the needs of digital-first, global merchants

- The Reserve Bank of India stated that VFS Capital Ltd, a Kolkata-based microfinance institution, has withdrawn its application submitted under the guidelines for 'on tap' licensing of small finance banks.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) released a draft circular proposing limits on banks' exposure to capital markets and acquisition finance.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has proposed allowing banks to finance up to 70% of the acquisition value for corporate takeovers.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has introduced an offline digital rupee feature allowing users to make payments even without Internet or telecom connectivity.
- As per the latest data, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI)'s gold reserves crossed 880 metric tonnes in the first half of FY 2025-26.
- The RBI's Payment Systems Report highlighted that between 2019 and 2024, credit card transactions in India doubled in volume (from 2,087 million to 4,472 million) and nearly tripled in value (from Rs 7.1 trillion to Rs 20.4 trillion).

- The 4th FATF Plenary Meeting in Paris under the Mexican Presidency adopted the first two mutual evaluation reports for Belgium and Malaysia, highlighting effectiveness in combating money laundering, terrorism, and proliferation financing.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the 22nd ASEAN–India Summit virtually, held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, under the 2025 ASEAN theme “Inclusivity and Sustainability.”
- Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers’ Welfare and Rural Development, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan participated in the National Agricultural Students Conference organised at Pusa, New Delhi
- The 14th India-Bhutan Meeting on Border Management and Security was held in Thimphu, Bhutan
- India actively participated in the 10th Session of the COP10 held at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris and was re-elected as Vice-Chairperson of the Asia-Pacific Bureau (Group IV) for the 2025–2027 term.
- The Indian Army hosted the United Nations Troop Contributing Countries (UNTCC) Chiefs Conclave 2025 at the Manekshaw Centre in New Delhi, bringing together senior military leadership from 32 nations and UN officials.
- GITEX Global, held at Dubai World Trade Centre and Dubai Harbour, is the world’s largest technology and artificial intelligence showcase, with over 6,800 exhibitors, 2,000 startups, and 1,200 investors from more than 180 countries.
- At the recent IMO meeting, 57 countries, under pressure from the United States, voted to postpone the carbon-free shipping framework by one year, despite 63 nations—including India—supporting early adoption.

- Union Electronics and IT Minister Sh. Ashwini Vaishnaw announced the approval of the first tranche of 7 projects under the Electronics Components Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS).
- The Central Government has launched the ₹600 crore “Kapas Kranti Mission” to promote high-yield, long-staple cotton cultivation using advanced agricultural techniques and technology.
- The Union Agriculture Ministry revised the norms of the Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) scheme to give states and UTs flexibility to plan micro-level water conservation projects beyond previous funding limits
- Under the Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY), over 9.19 crore hospital admissions worth ₹1.29 lakh crore have been facilitated since 2018, with dialysis being the most availed treatment.
- The ‘Shraddhanjali’ scheme, launched by Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma, aims to ensure the dignified return of mortal remains of Assamese residents who die outside the state.
- In 2025, the Government of India launched two major agricultural schemes: PM Dhan Dhaanya Krishi Yojana and Mission for Aatmanirbharta in Pulses.
- The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved a ₹1,500 crore Incentive Scheme to develop recycling capacity in the country for the separation and production of critical minerals from secondary sources.


