- The RBI has proposed reducing risk weights on high-quality infrastructure projects financed by NBFCs to encourage long-term project lending.
- Projects with at least 10% repayment of the sanctioned amount will now attract a 50% risk weight, and those with 5–10% repayment will attract 75% risk weight, instead of the earlier uniform 100%.
- If a project later fails to meet repayment or quality standards, a 100% risk weight will apply again.
- To qualify as a high-quality project, it must complete one year of satisfactory operations after the Date of Commencement of Commercial Operations (DCCO).
- Feedback on the draft is open till 21st November 2025, with implementation effective from 1st April 2026.

- As per RBI data, the total number of Prepaid Payment Instrument (PPI) cards increased 10.7% over six months to reach 483 million as of June 30, 2025, up from 436 million.

- Abhishek Sharma achieved 1,000 T20I runs in just 528 balls, becoming the fastest Indian to do so, surpassing Suryakumar Yadav's record of 573 balls.
- 21-year-old Raahul VS from Chennai, Tamil Nadu became India's 91st Chess Grandmaster after winning the 6th ASEAN Individual Chess Championship in the Philippines and crossing the required 2500 FIDE rating.
- FIFA has created a new annual award called the FIFA Peace Prize, which will be presented for the first time during the 2026 World Cup draw in Washington.
- Indian Oil Mumbai won the 42nd edition of the Indian Oil Servo Surjit Hockey Trophy for the 3rd consecutive year and 7th time overall by defeating Indian Railways Delhi 2-1 in the final held at Olympian Surjit Hockey Stadium, Jalandhar.

- **Trishul 2025** is a tri-Service combat exercise involving the Indian Army, Navy, and Air Force, held at India's western border with Pakistan.
- The Indian Air Force is participating in 'Ocean Sky 2025', a multinational air combat exercise which is being hosted by the Spanish Air Force at Gando Air Base in the Canary Islands in Spain.
- The Indian Naval Ship INS Sahyadri, a Shivalik-class guided missile stealth frigate, participated in JAIMEX-25 held from October 16–18, 2025, with Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force (JMSDF) ships.
- India and the European Union conducted a first-of-its-kind counterterrorism training at the National Security Guard campus in Manesar, Haryana
- **Samudra Shakti 2025** is the 5th edition of a bilateral naval exercise held between the Indian Navy (IN) and the Indonesian Navy at Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

- The upgrade provides interim functional stealth capability to frontline IAF fighters years before the fifth-generation AMCA enters service.
- The system has two key components:
  - Radar Warning Receiver (RWR) for instant detection and pilot alerts.
  - Advanced Self-Protection Jammer (ASPJ) based on DRFM technology to generate deceptive signals and jam hostile radars or missile systems.

## Recent News Headlines Related to DRDO

- The Indian Army signed a contract for the procurement of its first indigenously designed and manufactured Software Defined Radios (SDRs) developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- DRDO, in collaboration with the Integrated Defense Staff (IDS) and the Tri-Services, formally released 'Indian Radio Software Architecture (IRSA) Standard 1.0' to enable seamless interoperability across Army, Navy, and Air Force radio systems.
- India's DRDO is preparing to test its next-generation hypersonic missile, Dhvani, before the year ends.
- DRDO, in partnership with the Strategic Forces Command, successfully conducted the test launch of the next-generation Intermediate Range Agni-Prime (Agni-P) missile from a Rail-Based Mobile Launcher at Abdul Kalam Island, off the Odisha coast.
- The Signal Star Naval Flare System was developed by the High Energy Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL), a lab under the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- Defence Metallurgical Research Laboratory (DMRL), a DRDO lab based in Hyderabad, transferred three advanced material technologies to industry partners to boost indigenous defence manufacturing.
- DRDO has successfully conducted user trials of India's first quasi-ballistic missile, Pralay, from the Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island, off the coast of Odisha.

- Miniratna Category-I status allows these PSUs to make capital expenditure decisions up to ₹500 crore or up to their net worth, without needing prior government approval.
- This enhances operational autonomy and strengthens indigenous defence manufacturing capabilities.

- This recognition strengthens their operational and financial autonomy, enabling faster decision-making and improved efficiency in defence production.
