- Over 7.7 lakh cases were deemed non-maintainable and closed at the CRPC level.
- Complaints against banks were highest at 2.41 lakh (81.53%), followed by NBFCs with 43.8K cases (14.80%).

- The move aims to streamline lending, enhance transparency, and strengthen risk management.

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

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

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
