- Nearly 60% of Digital Life Certificates generated by pensioners used Aadhaar face authentication; overall, 28.29 crore face authentication transactions were done in November 2025, up from 12.04 crore in November 2024.
- e-KYC transactions also rose significantly to 47.19 crore in November 2025, a more than 24% increase from November 2024.

- The inaugural special train of the new Jaisalmer–Delhi (Shakur Basti) rail service was flagged off from Jaisalmer station by Union Ministers Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw and Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat.
- Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw inaugurated a Skill India Centre at Ch. Kehar Singh Divya Public School, Baraut, Baghpat, Uttar Pradesh.
- The India Meteorological Department (IMD) inaugurated two state-of-the-art C-band Doppler Weather Radars — one in Mangaluru (Karnataka) and one in Raipur (Chhattisgarh). These are the first Doppler Weather Radars for both states.

- In the first half of FY26, banks have already disbursed ₹14.51 lakh crore in farm loans.
- FY25 performance: Total agriculture credit was ₹28.69 lakh crore, provided by commercial banks, cooperatives, and RRBs.
- Loan share: 60% short-term crop loans and 40% investment credit (agriculture and allied sectors).
- Regional disparity: Southern states (Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu) received 48% of agricultural loans in FY25, despite having only 17% of India's gross cropped area.
- NABARD identifies the causes as weak rural financial infrastructure and low financial literacy in many other states.

- Technical specifications include length 14.5 m, wingspan 10 m, height 3.5 m, payload 1,500 kg, maximum take-off weight 8.5 tons, maximum speed 0.9 Mach, cruise speed 0.6 Mach, combat radius 500 nautical miles, operational altitude 25,000 ft, and endurance over 3 hours.

- INS Aridhaman is India's third nuclear-powered ballistic missile submarine (SSBN), designed for strategic nuclear deterrence.
- NASA's Perseverance rover has recorded electrical discharges in Mars' atmosphere, providing the first-ever documented proof of an electrically active Martian atmosphere.
- Oman launched its first communication satellite – OmanSat-1, marking a major step towards digital independence and Oman Vision 2040 goals.
- India will launch its first privately built PSLV rocket, named PSLV-N1, in early 2026.
