

- Expected to reduce unemployment from 3.2% to 1.9%–2.9% depending on scenario.
- All workers become eligible for minimum wages under the Code on Wages, potentially increasing daily income by ₹95, leading to higher consumption.
- Formalisation of workforce expected to rise by 15.1%, reaching 75.5% in the formal sector.
- 44 crore workers are in the unorganised sector; 31 crore registered on e-Shram portal.

- GST collections increased compared to the previous month, indicating a rise in consumer demand.
- Fiscal, monetary, and regulatory measures are expected to create a virtuous cycle of higher private investment, productivity, and growth.
- Merchandise trade deficit reached an all-time high due to surging imports (gold & silver) despite export contraction.

- Delisted securities are proposed to be excluded similar to already-excluded suspended securities due to lack of price discovery and liquidity.
- Illiquid securities will still be valued at last closing price. Reassessment of BSDA eligibility is proposed quarterly instead of varying billing cycles.
- SEBI suggests easier consent methods for investors preferring normal demat accounts.

- **PM-USHA (Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan)** is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme launched by the Ministry of Education in June 2023 to improve the quality and accessibility of higher education in State institutions, aligned with NEP 2020 pillars – Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability, Accountability.
- Over ₹3.25 lakh crore has been deposited under Sukanya Samridhi Yojana (SSY), a government-backed savings scheme for securing education and marriage expenses of a girl child.
- **PM-AJAY** is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme launched in 2021 under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, aiming at the upliftment of Scheduled Caste (SC) communities in India.
- Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) has proposed a ₹30,000-crore outlay for the modified UDAN (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik) scheme to enhance regional air connectivity beyond April 2027.
- Union Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya launched the Employee Enrollment Scheme 2025 to encourage employers to voluntarily declare and enroll eligible employees under the Employees' Provident Fund.

- The rise was mainly driven by higher rice (124.504 mt) and maize (28.303 mt) production due to abundant and widespread monsoon rainfall.
- Coarse cereals output estimated at 41.414 mt; pulses slightly lower at 7.41 mt; oilseeds at 27.563 mt.
- Groundnut output rose to 11.09 mt (better yields in Gujarat); soybean lower at 14.26 mt; sugarcane up to 475.614 mt; cotton down to 29.215 million bales.

- Improvement is credited to the Montreal Protocol, which reduced ozone-depleting chemicals like CFCs, chlorine, and bromine compounds.
- Ozone-depleting substances have fallen by about one-third since the 2000 peak.
- Weather factors such as a weaker polar vortex and warmer stratosphere also limited ozone loss.
- Balloon soundings at the South Pole recorded a minimum of 147 Dobson Units in early October, better than 92 DU in 2006.
