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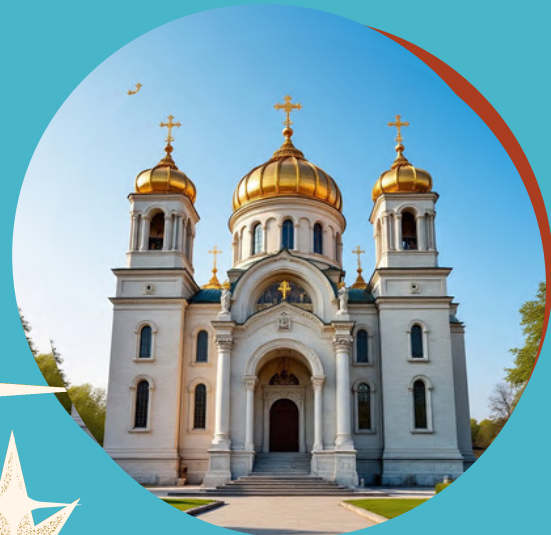

Explanation:

- Retail inflation dropped to a record low of 0.25% in October 2025.
- The fall was driven by GST rate cuts, favourable base effect, and reduced food inflation, especially in vegetables and fruits.
- This is the lowest retail inflation rate recorded in the current CPI series.
- It is also the lowest inflation rate since January 2012.
- The decline was mainly due to the statistical impact of the base effect on food inflation.

- Additionally, some NBFCs such as Parichay Commotrade Pvt Ltd (Mumbai) and Renuka Investments and Finance Limited (UP) surrendered their CoR voluntarily.

 - Net NPA ratio: 0.45%
- The meeting also saw the launch of the Startup Loans module on the JanSamarth Portal and the release of the PSB Manthan 2025 report.

- The scheme supports Indian exporters, especially in labour-intensive sectors like textiles, leather, gems & jewellery, and marine products, who face US tariffs and non-tariff barriers.
- EPM will operate through two sub-schemes:
 - Niryat Protsahan: export finance, interest subvention, collateral support
 - Niryat Disha: tackling non-tariff barriers, market access, logistics, compliance, and testing support

- Under this structure, zirconium has been assigned the lowest royalty rate of 1%.
- Graphite with 80%+ fixed carbon will attract 2% of ASP, while graphite with less than 80% fixed carbon will have a 4% royalty.
- Caesium and rubidium will be charged 2% of ASP based on metal content.
- These minerals are vital for high-tech applications and energy transition.
- Currently, nine graphite mines are operational in India, and both graphite and zirconium are listed among the 24 critical minerals under the MMDR Act, 1957.

- It provides clear instructions for victims, intermediaries, and law enforcement agencies to ensure swift and uniform action against NCII, including intimate or morphed images shared without consent.
- Intermediaries are required to remove or disable access to flagged NCII content within 24 hours of receiving a complaint.
- The Indian Cybercrime Coordination Centre (I4C) acts as the central aggregator for NCII complaints and maintains a secure NCII hash bank.
- Significant social media intermediaries must also implement hash-matching and crawler technologies.
- If such content is hosted on external websites, intermediaries must alert I4C through the Sahyog Portal for quick follow-up and inform the affected individuals.

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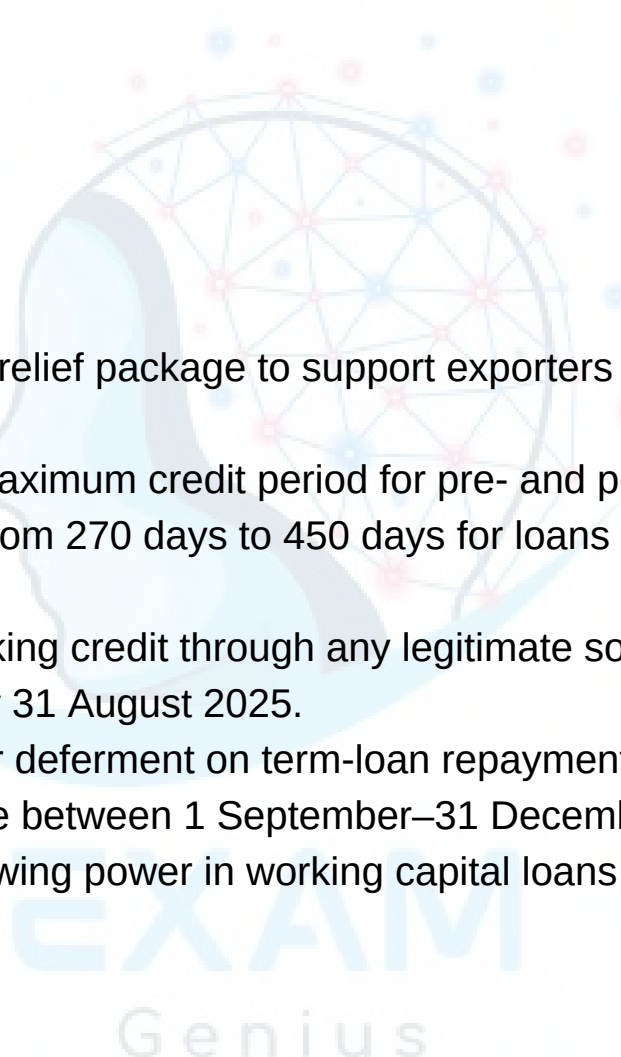

- Lenders can liquidate packing credit through any legitimate source for exporters who could not dispatch goods by 31 August 2025.
- RBI allowed moratorium or deferment on term-loan repayments and interest recovery on working capital loans due between 1 September–31 December 2025.
- Banks can recalculate drawing power in working capital loans by reducing margins or reassessment.

- Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) for persons aged 15+ increased from 55% to 55.1%.

- IESH collects households' perceptions on price movements and inflation across 19 major cities.
- RCCS is a bi-monthly survey capturing rural and semi-urban household views on economy, employment, prices, income and spending across 31 States/UTs.
- UCCS is also bi-monthly and gathers urban consumer sentiments on economy, employment, income, spending and price trends across 19 cities.

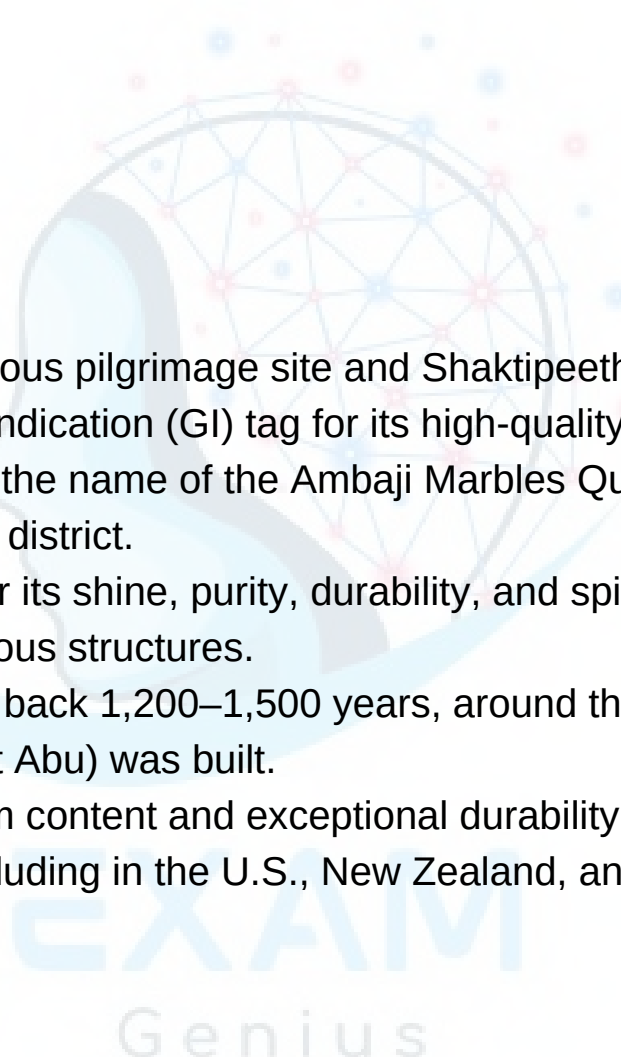
