- RBI has invited public comments on the draft till 28 January 2026.
- Currently, NBFCs (other than NBFC-UL) and ARCs calculate Tier-1 Capital based on figures as of 31 March of the previous year.
- Under the new draft, free reserves, including quarterly profits, may be included in Owned Fund, subject to specified conditions.
- Eligible profits will be reduced by 25% of the average dividend paid over the last three years, multiplied by the number of completed quarters in the year.



- These restrictions will apply to 94 villages spread across nearly 243 km adjoining the sanctuary boundary.
- Kumbhalgarh Wildlife Sanctuary spans across Rajsamand, Pali, and Udaipur districts and is considered one of the most fragile ecosystems of the Aravalli range.

- A daily penalty of ₹30 lakh for 68 days (from 5 December to 10 February) amounted to ₹20.40 crore.
- DGCA's inquiry found issues such as over-optimisation of operations, inadequate regulatory preparedness, and management shortcomings.
- The airline failed to properly implement revised Flight Duty Time Limitation (FDTL) norms.
- Excessive focus on maximising crew and aircraft utilisation reduced roster buffer margins and weakened operational resilience.
