- Rural female LFPR increased steadily from 35.2% in June 2025 to 39.7% in November 2025, while urban female LFPR remained broadly stable at around 25.5%.
- The Worker Population Ratio (WPR), which represents the percentage of population aged 15 years and above that is employed, improved to 53.2% in November 2025 from 52.5% in October 2025.
- Rural female WPR rose from 36.9% in October 2025 to 38.4% in November 2025, and overall female WPR increased from 32.4% to 33.4%.



- The mission aims to ensure safe orbital flight, controlled re-entry, and recovery of the crew in the Indian Ocean.

- Akash-NG is the successor to the Akash Mark-1 and Akash Prime missile systems and is designed to counter a wide range of aerial threats, including high-speed aircraft, drones, and cruise missiles, with improved accuracy and responsiveness.
- The Akash-NG is a medium-range surface-to-air missile system developed by DRDO and produced by Bharat Dynamics Limited (BDL) and Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL).
- The missile has a strike range of about 70–80 kilometres and can achieve speeds between Mach 2.5 and Mach 3.

- The satellite was built by US-based AST SpaceMobile Inc. under a commercial agreement with NewSpace India Limited (NSIL).
- Weighing about 6,100 kg, it is the heaviest commercial payload ever launched by India.
- The satellite enables direct cellular broadband connectivity, allowing standard smartphones to access global 4G/5G voice calls, video calls, messaging, streaming, and data services without any special hardware.
