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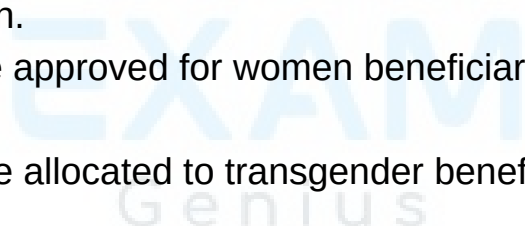

- The plan is implemented at the PACS (Primary Agricultural Credit Society) level by converging multiple schemes such as Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF), Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure (AMI), Sub-Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM), and PMFME.
