- Under the new framework, dividend payouts are primarily linked to the Common Equity Tier-1 (CET1) Ratio and Adjusted Profit After Tax (PAT).
- Generally, the maximum dividend payout is capped at 75% of PAT.
- Banks with CET1 above 20% may distribute up to 100% of adjusted profit, subject to the overall cap.
- Banks must maintain minimum regulatory capital requirements before and after dividend distribution. Adjusted PAT is calculated as PAT minus 50% of net NPAs.

- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) issued the NBFC–Miscellaneous Amendment Directions, 2026 to support the functioning of National Urban Co-operative Finance and Development Corporation Ltd. (NUCFDC) as the Umbrella Organisation (UO) for Urban Co-operative Banks (UCBs). These special provisions will remain effective until 31 March 2029, unless modified, withdrawn, or extended by the Reserve Bank of India.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) purchased ₹50,000 crore worth of Government Securities (G-Secs) through Open Market Operations (OMO) to increase liquidity in the banking system.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has proposed a compensation framework for small-value fraudulent digital banking transactions up to ₹50,000.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved SBI Mutual Fund to acquire an aggregate holding of up to 9.99% in private sector lender Bandhan Bank.

- Kaziranga National Park in Assam is an important part of the Central Asian Flyway, a major migratory route for birds.
- The bird count exceeds the Ramsar Criterion 5, which requires at least 20,000 waterbirds for a wetland to be considered of international importance.
