- The proceeds from monetisation will be used for capital expenditure and new infrastructure creation, and revenues from central projects will flow to the Consolidated Fund of India.

Key Proposals in RBI Draft Framework

- Eligible participants include other AD banks, overseas entities, IFSC Banking Units (IBUs), and Offshore Banking Units (OBUs).
- Transactions may be undertaken directly or through overseas branches on a back-to-back basis.
- The framework also includes provisions related to IFSC presence, offshore electronic trading platforms (ETPs), liberalisation of forex operations, and deployment of surplus foreign currency funds.
