- These guidelines were issued by the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA).
- Insurers must submit compliance status within 15 days.
- Dark patterns refer to misleading UI/UX designs that manipulate users into unintended actions.

- Black bin is for hazardous/special care waste like batteries, bulbs, electronics and medicines.
- Penalties will be imposed for non-compliance under the “Polluter Pays” principle.

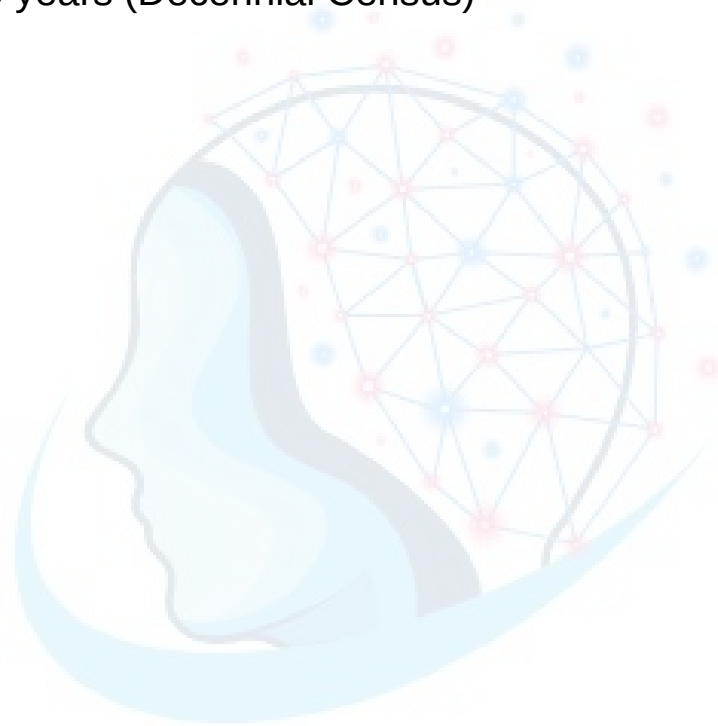

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IMPORTANT ONE - LINER Current Affairs

The Telangana government has launched the Bhu Bharati portal, an integrated land record management system aimed at simplifying land registration and record services. The new system replaces the earlier Dharani portal.

The JanSamarth Portal was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on June 6, 2022. The portal integrates 15 credit-linked Central Government schemes. As of March 20, 2026, around 254 lenders have been onboarded on the platform. Since its launch, about 41.14 lakh applications worth ₹1,06,306 crore have been processed.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved Emirates NBD to acquire up to 74% stake in RBL Bank. As per norms, foreign banks can acquire up to 74% stake in an Indian bank.
