- PMJJBY offers life insurance coverage for death due to any cause with a premium of ₹436 per year.
- The scheme covers individuals aged 18–50 years and provides a benefit of ₹2 lakh.
- PMSBY recorded the highest enrolments among the three schemes with 58.09 crore cumulative enrolments.
- PMSBY paid ₹3,667.52 crore for 1,84,662 claims.
- PMSBY provides accidental death and disability insurance with an annual premium of ₹20.
- The scheme covers individuals aged 18–70 years and offers accidental death cover up to ₹2 lakh.
- APY recorded 9.04 crore enrolments as on 30 April 2026.
- APY provides a guaranteed monthly pension ranging from ₹1,000 to ₹5,000 after the age of 60 years.
- APY is administered by PFRDA under the National Pension System (NPS).

- India currently has around 14.71 lakh schools and 24.69 crore students.
- Only 5.4% schools provide continuous education from Grade 1 to 12, which the report described as a “pyramid structure”.
- The number of schools declines sharply at the higher secondary level, with only 1.64 lakh schools available.
- Nearly 7,993 schools reported zero student enrolment, with the highest numbers in West Bengal and Telangana.
- The report recommended replacing “cylindrical schooling” with composite schools covering Grades 1–12 under one roof.
- Reading proficiency among Grade 8 students declined from 74.7% in 2014 to 71.1% in 2024.
- According to PARAKH 2024, less than 30% of Grade 6 students were competent in fractions.
- The report highlighted overdependence on rote learning and weak conceptual understanding among students.

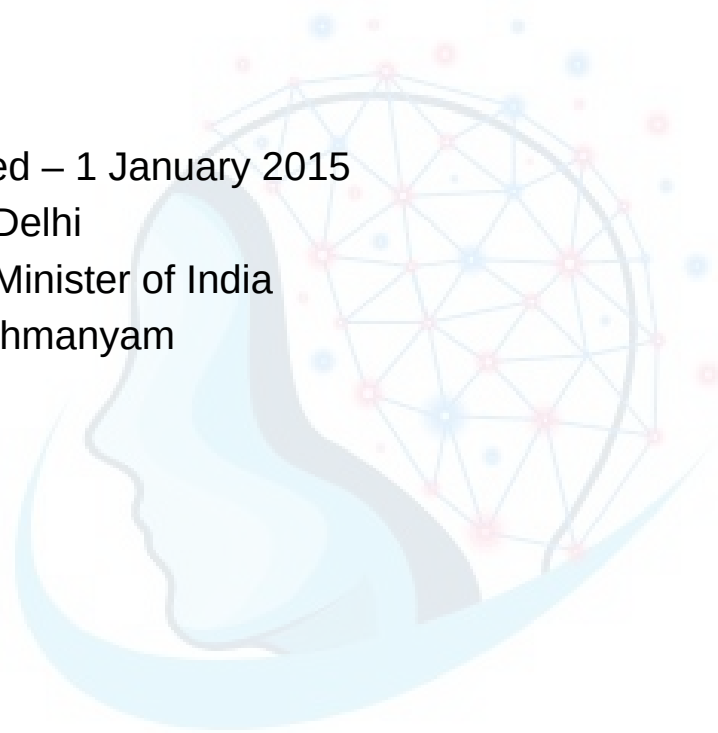




- It also raised concerns regarding teacher quality and competency levels.
- Studies cited in the report showed that only 2% of teachers scored above 70% in mathematics assessments.
- The report warned that introducing AI and Computational Thinking without proper teacher training may affect students' independent thinking.
